| <h2>DEA Controlled Substances</h2>  | <p>Schedule I – V pharmaceuticals that are highly regulated by DEA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ketamine• Diazepam• Codeine <p>Schedule I – V regulated DEA pharmaceuticals still in syringes or I.V. bags</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keep inventory and lock up• Contact EHS to be added to next scheduled incinerator burn• DEA approved user transports waste to incinerator and witnesses burn• Empty into approved container that may be disposed of at EHS incinerator• Contact EHS for container suggestion• Same as above for disposal |  |
| | <p>Dual waste = Hazardous waste that contains a DEA controlled substance</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Disposal thru reverse distributor. Expensive, make every effort to avoid creating this waste• Contact EHS for disposal |  |
